

# EXCAVATOR NOTIFICATION

This is to inform you that excavation or demolition without first notifying Louisiana One Call may be hazardous to you and others, and that digging without a LA One Call ticket number may also be in violation of state law.

Civil penalties of up to \$25,000 for violations  
of the Louisiana Underground Utilities and Facilities Damage Prevention Law.

## DIG SAFELY NO EXCUSES!

State law requires you to provide a 48-hour notice, and Louisiana One Call will alert members with nearby underground facilities so that they can mark them

for you FREE. There are no good excuses to dig or excavate without a LA One Call ticket number.

“But this is a rush job!”

### State law requires that you phone 48 hours in advance

unless your work is a "crisis situation which poses an imminent threat or danger to life, health, or property and requires immediate action." Even then, you must call "as soon as practicable" so that the one-call center can arrange for emergency markings.

“But I know there’s nothing down there.”

### Don’t bet your life on it.

Pipelines and cables can shift in Louisiana soils, and new facilities are installed every day – often by directional boring, which leaves no trace on the surface. That’s why you must call, no matter how well you think you know your work site.

“But I’m a government employee.”

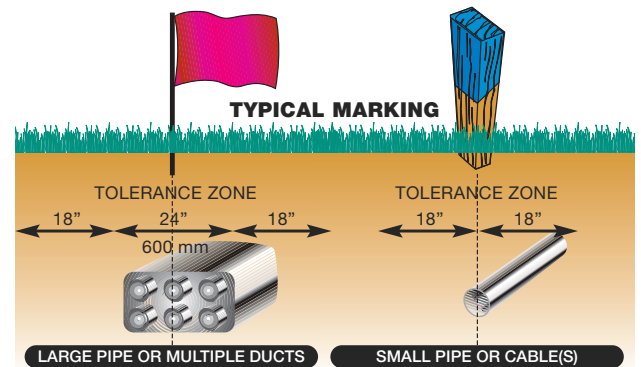
### Unsafe excavation or demolition is dangerous and illegal

no matter who is involved. The law makes no exceptions for government employees at any level.

“But somebody from headquarters already called weeks ago.”

### Locate marks expire in ten calendar days

from the mark-by time, or when they are no longer visible. If you can’t see the marks, or if they were placed more than 10 days ago, you must call again. Your LA One Call ticket number is proof of your call, so keep it handy.



- RED ..... Electric Power Lines, Cables, Conduit and Lighting Cables
- YELLOW .. Gas, Oil, Steam, Petroleum or Gaseous Materials
- ORANGE .. Communication, Alarm or Signal Lines, Cables or Conduit
- PURPLE .. Reclaimed Water, Irrigation and Slurry Lines
- GREEN .... Sewers and Drain Lines
- BLUE ..... Potable Water
- PINK ..... Temporary Survey Markings
- WHITE ..... Proposed Excavation
